WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

DIXON LOOKS TO REPEAT AT THE BEACH: The usually slow-starting Scott Dixon dominated the season's first oval race of the season, winning at Phoenix on April 2. Now the four-time series champion aims for another win at the track he claimed his first win of 2015 – Long Beach. Can the Kiwi claim another win on the streets of Long Beach and join the prestigious list of back-to-back winners that includes Mario Andretti, Sebastien Bourdais, Paul Tracy, Al Unser Jr. and Alex Zanardi?



BOURDAIS, MONTOYA LOOK TO PICK UP WHERE THEY LEFT OFF: Sebastien Bourdais and Juan Pablo Montoya hope to continue their mastery of the streets of Long Beach. Bourdais, who won three times on the circuit as part of his four consecutive Champ Car titles, races for KVSH Racing, while Montoya, the 1999 Long Beach winner, returns with Team Penske. Can either get back to winner's circle this weekend?

CALIFORNIA KIDS: A native of Camarillo, Calif., Charlie Kimball grew up with the Long Beach street circuit nearly in his backyard. The Rio Mesa High grad returns to his “home track” looking for his first win in home state. Alexander Rossi hails from Nevada City, Calif., and will be making his first start at Long Beach. Can either California native pull off an impressive finish in front of friends and family?

DALY RETURNS TO LONG BEACH: Answering a last minute call up from Dale Coyne Racing, Conor Daly made an impressive Long Beach debut in 2015. Now a full-time driver for the team, the second-generation racer hopes to really show what he can do at the track with a full weekend to prepare the car for him.
