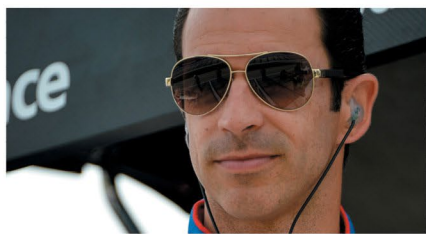

## WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

### CASTRONEVES AIMS FOR FIRST TORONTO WIN:

Helio Castroneves took control of the Verizon IndyCar Series point standings at Iowa and carries a nine-point advantage into the Toronto doubleheader weekend. But the Brazilian hasn't fared well in Toronto, scoring his best finish of second in last season's second race. Can Castroneves score his first Toronto victory and maintain his points lead over teammate Will Power?



**WELCOME TO HINCHTOWN:** James Hinchcliffe has attended every Honda Indy Toronto since he was 18 months old. This year, the Toronto native returns to his hometown race among the favorites to win. Can the Mayor of Hinchtown visit Victory Lane in his hometown for the first time?

**WILL TO WIN AT TORONTO?:** Will Power has already won on street courses at St. Petersburg and Detroit and the 2010 Honda Indy Toronto champion would like to add another win on the streets of Exhibition Place to his résumé. The Australian has a pair of wins at Toronto, winning in 2007 at the temporary circuit in Champ Car and again in 2010. Can Power become a three-time race winner at the circuit and retake the lead in the Verizon IndyCar Series point standings?

**HUNTER-REAY SEEKS ANOTHER VICTORY:** 2014 Indianapolis 500 winner Ryan Hunter-Reay used a three-race win streak that included a victory at Toronto to propel himself into championship contention in 2012. He returns to the track seeking to repeat the feat coming off a win in Iowa. Can Hunter-Reay, who has three podium finishes in his last five starts in Toronto, make history repeat itself?
