## WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

**RAHAL RETURNS TO HOME RACE:** Graham Rahal returns to Mid-Ohio behind the wheel of the car fielded by Rahal Letterman Lanigan Racing, co-owned by his father, Bobby. The Rahal name is synonymous with Victory Circle at Mid-Ohio and the driver of the No. 15 National Guard car would like nothing more than to win at his "home track." Can Rahal combine a strong qualifying effort with a mistake-free race to earn his first victory of the season?



**HELIO LOOKS TO KEEP POINTS LEAD:** Helio Castroneves took control of the Verizon IndyCar Series standings from teammate Will Power at Iowa Speedway on July 12 and carries a 13-point advantage over the Australian into the Honda Indy 200 at Mid-Ohio. Can Castroneves, who hasn't won at Mid-Ohio since 2001, get some breathing room in a tight title fight with a strong performance this weekend?

**HUNTER-REAY SEEKS A RETURN TO TITLE CONTENTION:** Indianapolis 500 winner Ryan Hunter-Reay, who picked up the Best Driver ESPY Award on July 16, is third in the championship standings 69 points out of the lead. Can the driver of the No. 28 DHL car, who has a series-best three victories this season, get back into title contention with a strong finish at Mid-Ohio?
