## WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS WEEKEND:

**CHAMPIONSHIP RACE HEADS TO SONOMA:** Will Power took back the lead in the Verizon IndyCar Series standings from teammate Helio Castroneves at Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course on Aug. 3 and following his win at Milwaukee, now carries a 39-point advantage over the Brazilian into the GoPro Grand Prix of Sonoma. Can Power score his fourth win at Sonoma and pad his points lead for the season finale at Auto Club Speedway?
