WHAT TO WATCH FOR THIS MONTH:

IT'S NOT WHERE YOU START...: The last four Indianapolis 500 winners have started outside the top 10, including Juan Pablo Montoya, who came from 15th to win in 2015. With depth throughout the 33-car field for the Indy 500, including former winners Montoya, Scott Dixon and Tony Kanaan starting from the fifth row or further back, can another star drive through the field to win the race?

SECOND-GENERATION STARS HOPE TO ADD TO FAMILY LEGACY: The latest generation from two of open-wheel racing's most familiar families comes to Indianapolis in hopes of adding to the family legacy. Marco Andretti—the grandson of 1969 winner Mario Andretti and son of Michael Andretti—has finished in the top three at Indy three times in his nine previous starts. He hopes to give his father's team its fourth Indianapolis 500 win. Another son hoping to return his father's team to Victory Lane is Graham Rahal. The son of former Indy winner Bobby Rahal had a breakthrough season in 2015 and aims to repeat history 30 years after Bobby won the 500.

PAGENAUD TRIES FOR INDIANAPOLIS SWEEP: After winning the Angie's List Grand Prix of Indianapolis, the Verizon IndyCar Series' hottest driver Simon Pagenaud of Team Penske aims to make more history by gunning for his fourth-straight win. Pagenaud could become the first Verizon IndyCar Series driver to win on both the IMS Road Course and Oval. Can Pagenaud continue his history-making Month of May?



PENSKE SEEKS HISTORY: Team owner Roger Penske has won the Indianapolis 500 a record 16 times and will also drive the pace car to start the 100th Running of the race. He brings four strong entries in 2016 with three-time Indianapolis 500 winner Helio Castroneves, two-time Indianapolis 500 winner Juan Pablo Montoya, series points leader Simon Pagenaud, and former Verizon IndyCar Series champion Will Power. Can the fearsome foursome become the first team to lock out the podium and complete the Captain's sweep?

DIVERSE ROOKIE CLASS HOPES TO MAKE STRONG IMPRESSION: A class of five rookies featuring four Mazda Road to Indy race winners and a Formula 1 starter will make their first Indy 500 start. The 2016 Rookie class is headed by fastest rookie Alexander Rossi, 2015 Indy Lights champ Spencer Pigot and rising stars Matt Brabham, Max Chilton and Stefan Wilson.

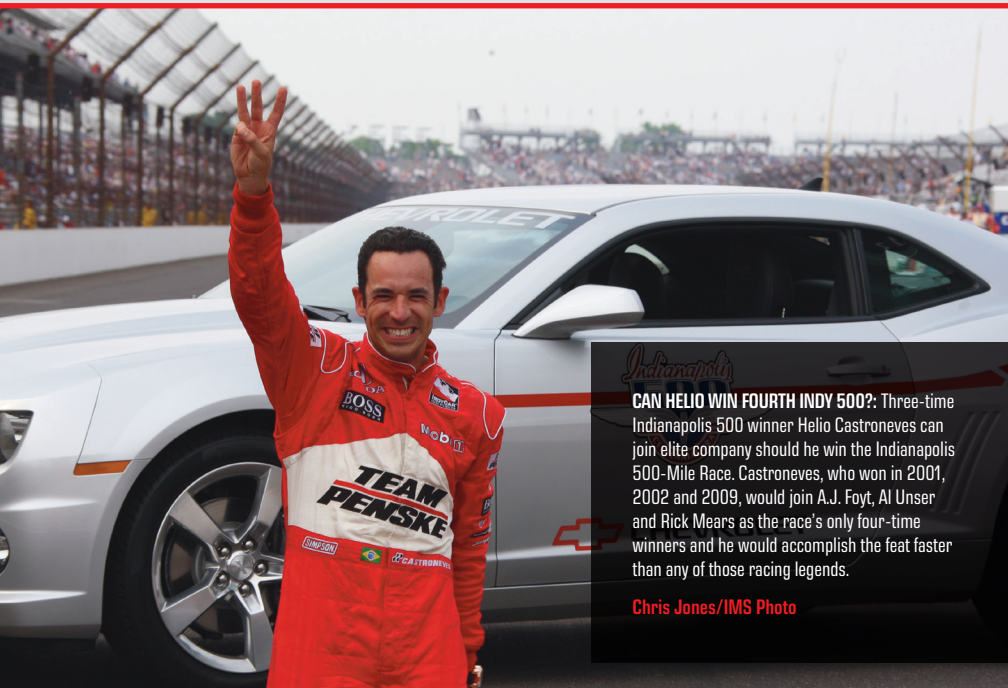
